

Citizens :MK Research into TVP.

A survey was undertaken by 366 junior children across Jubilee Wood and Southwood (Fishermead, Oldbrook, Central MK, Conniburrow and Downs Barn)

1) Have you ever spoken to the police? YES: 44% NO: 56%

2) If you have spoken to the police what was it about?

a) I needed help with something: 16%

b) I wanted to tell them something: 8%

c) They asked me about something that happened: 29%

d) Just for a chat: 47%

2) I find the police friendly: strongly agree agree disagree strongly disagree
56% 36% 6% 2%

Comment: Of those children who have had contact with the police the vast majority felt the contact was friendly and therefore they are open to further contact

3) I feel able to ask the police for help if I feel worried:

strongly agree agree disagree strongly disagree
53% 21% 14% 11%

Comment: 1 in 4 children would not approach the police if they were worried

4) Would you like to meet with the police more often?

strongly agree agree disagree strongly disagree
41% 27% 16% 17%

Comment: Although it would seem the those children who had contact with the police found them friendly and trustworthy we still have 1 in 3 children who feel negative about meeting the police.
